Sarah Nelson Womble Distinguished Service in Literacy Award

Award Criteria for the ARA Distinguished Service Literacy Award

- 1. This award is designed to recognize an individual who has distinguished himself or herself in the promotion of Literacy statewide and/or nationally. Their efforts should have far reaching affect on the quality of information given and the number of individuals it has impacted. Efforts have resulted in state or national literacy prominence.
- 2. This award will not duplicate any other award that is given by ARA i.e. awards to educator, administrator, agency or community leader.
- 3. The nominations will come from the ARA board.
- 4. The president will receive the nomination by the April 15th. The nomination will be accompanied by a written summary of the person's accomplishments.
- 5. Board Members will receive a copy of the nomination and selection of the recipient will be based on consensus of the board at the transition meeting.
- 6. The President of ARA will notify the recipient of their selection prior to July 1st.
- 7. Membership in ARA, IRA or a local council is not required. The award will be accompanied with an ARA lifetime membership.
- 8. The award will be presented at the Fall Conference.
- 9. This award is not an annual award. If the nominee is not highly qualified, the award does not have to be given.
- 10. Announcement of this award will be included in the ARA publications and released to the media.
- 11. Nominee may not be previous recipient.
